

PRESS RELEASE Energy Delivery Plan

Connect Saint Helena Ltd (Connect) has today published its Energy Delivery Plan. This is available via the Connect website at http://www.connect.co.sh/electricity-generation1.html

The Energy Delivery Plan provides a roadmap for phased delivery of improvements in the energy sector on St Helena, particularly to support plans for energy transition on St Helena. It supports the objective of reaching 80% electricity generation from renewable energy by 2027/28.

Connect is now reaching the end of a preliminary design period, having undertaken assessments of the existing wind infrastructure, potential for battery energy storage as well as the Grid Impact Assessment. The findings from the earlier studies are being collated and will inform plans for expanding renewable energy. Procurement is currently underway for a Modelling and Design Consultancy to prepare final designs.

The Energy Delivery Plan is a live document that will be updated as more information becomes available. Please note that the published version has been redacted in order not to prejudice the current procurement. More detail will follow on the preliminary studies over the coming weeks.
