ST HELENA UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY

DIRECTION UNDER SECTION 5(1)(C) OF THE UTILITY SERVICES ORDINANCE, 2013

Pursuant to section 5(1)(c) of the Utility Services Ordinance, 2013 the Utilities Regulatory Authority hereby directs that the maximum charges or fees that may be levied by a Utilities Provider for providing public utility services are amended from the 1st of December 2024 to include additional charges for empty properties.

An ‘**empty property**’ means any property that has used less than 10 kWh of electricity in the three months immediately prior to the date of the relevant bill for electricity services; and ‘**empty properties**’ shall be interpreted accordingly.

For empty properties the following standing charges shall apply in addition to any other fees or charges payable by the consumer:

CONSUMER	STANDING CHARGE PER QUARTER
Domestic	£45
Commercial	£60
Government	£60

Connection and Disconnection charges for all consumers are now as follows:

Disconnection	£45
Connection/Reconnection	£45
Reconnection within 6 months after a voluntary disconnection	£90
Reconnection from 6 months after a voluntary disconnection	£200
